**Meetings:** Every April and October at the State Trike-In or any special called meeting, as required, following BTW Bylaws.

**News:** Loner reports: Hi folks, it's that time again and I have a lot to talk about this time.

First, I hope that you all had a great summer, as did Leatha and I. We did not do as much riding as we would have liked, but then you all know that feeling. I hope that your year ends with some great holidays and family get togethers. May God watch over and bless you all.

Now to the California State Fall Trike-in. Friday night, we had our Directors meeting. It was asked in advance that this meeting be attended by Chapter Directors and State officers only. Chapter Director Bylaws were passed out to all Directors and they were asked to read and understand them. There is a California Members list on the BTW website that all Directors can access and find members in their chapters. I asked if each Director would put together a list of all members in their chapter and email them to me. There is a color code for the members list; Black = Active member, Gold = 30 days before expires, Red = Expired, Green = New member and stays green for 1 year, Blue Lifetime member.

Next, we went into one of the directors duties, which is to make sure that there is something written up for the Triker Magazine and the California Golden State Newsletter monthly. I do not care who writes it up. A director can have a secretary or news person do it but, it is the director's responsibility to make sure that it is done every month. All news is to be sent to Irv Creger, our News Editor at ([lrvtw@aol.com](mailto:lrvtw@aol.com)). He will send an email before it is due and the date it is due by. All pictures and flyers

you want published in Triker goes to Scottie Sisemore at ([btw\\_region1@cox.net](mailto:btw_region1@cox.net)). She will send it to Lady. This is the way that Lady said she likes it and is trying to get other states to copy our process.

I made a proposal to amend the Chapter Bylaws concerning the term limits for officers. It was passed by all directors to take it to the general membership. At the general membership meeting on Saturday night (10/23/10) it was voted to bypass Article VIII, Amendments, and have the vote on the change at this time. The temporary amendment was passed by a majority show of hands vote at this time.

Under Article VI Elections, Paragraph C., 'Term of Office.' There is a change in chapter officer terms of office from '1 to 3 years' to 'a 2 year term with elections to be held between Jan 1<sup>st</sup> and March 31<sup>st</sup> (1<sup>st</sup> Quarter) on every odd year.' That is just the opposite of the State Director election. This will make the State Director's job a lot easier knowing who the chapter directors are and for how long and it would give a new state director a little time in office before there is a directors meeting. I will have copies of the amended bylaws to hand out at the Spring Trike - In. It was also voted on by the general membership that the three Special Awards that we give out will go to the grounds crew for all they do to keep the fair grounds all cleaned up for us and helping out with tables etc.

On Saturday night, before the meeting, we were again asked to make some laps at the race track. We pulled one truck with our flags, 45 trikes and 2 motorcycles out on the track and were asked to stop and line up on the front straight, where we took place in their opening ceremonies. Everyone thought that was great being able to take part in that.

When we got back to camp, everyone was still talking about how much fun they had. Then we went into finishing the raffle where Michelle Serre won the tire clock that I made. Next were the trophy presentations.

Even with the threat of bad weather, we had 142 people sign in and again that is another high

number for me. The weather held off and all we had all weekend was what I kept calling heavy dew. But, it did not dampen anyone's spirits and a good time was had by all. There were 13 chapters that signed in at registration, many guests and a few from out of state.

All this is what makes this Trike-In so great and such a big success. Without this whole group pulling together, this could not happen, and again, I will say a big THANK YOU to all.
